

HAWAII LAWS ON SMOKING

State of Hawaii:

- **Smoking Ban on All Schools (K- 12) Campuses.** *May 2004.*
- **Prohibits Distribution of Sample Tobacco Products on or in Any Public Street, Sidewalk, or Park, 1,000 Feet of Any School Attended By Minors. Prohibits Distribution of Tobacco Promotional Materials within 1,000 Feet of Any School Attended By Minors.** *Act 272. 1999.*
- **Hawaii Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund, Rainy Day Fund, and Hawaii Tobacco Prevention & Control Trust Fund Created.** *Act 304. 1999.*
- **Sale of Single Cigarette or Packs Containing Less than 20 Cigarettes Prohibited.** *Act 53. Effective 6/96.*
- **Cigarette Sales Prohibited by Vending Machines and Lunch Wagons.** *Act 253, 1999. Act 313, 1996.*
- **Smoking Prohibited in Licensed Child Care Facilities during hours of operation.** *Act 68. Effective 7/93.*
- **Smoking in Public Place Statute.** *Act 234. Effective 9/87. Exceptions 1) Small Businesses; and 2) Retail Stores Less than 5000sq feet;*
- **Smoking in Workplace Statute.** *Act 245. Effective 9/87.* ● **Regulations on Smoking in the Office Work Place.** *June 24, 1987.*

City and County of Honolulu Ordinances:

- **Smoking Ban at Hawaii State Capitol Building.** *October 2004.*
- **Smoking Ban in Separate Bar Areas, in Food Courts and Seating Areas.** *Ordinance 02-06. July 1, 2003.* ● **Smoking Ban in Restaurants.** *July 1, 2002.*
- **Prohibits Selling, Giving Away or Furnishing Herbal Cigarettes to Minors.** *Ordinance 00-60. 2000.*
- **Prohibits Selling, Giving Away or Furnishing Bidi Cigarettes to Anyone.** *Ordinance 00-23. 2000.*
- **Sale of Fake ID's Regulated to Prevent Underage Youth from Using ID to Purchase Alcohol and Tobacco Products.** *Ordinance 99-66. 1999.*
- **Prohibits Placement of Tobacco Ads that are Visible Outside from Public Property within 1,000 Feet of Schools.** *Ordinance 98-10. 1998.*
- **Ban on Smoking in All Areas of City Owned or Controlled Buildings.** *Ordinance 94-24.*
- **Prohibit Smoking In Common Areas of Multi-family Dwellings & Multi-tenant Commercial Building, & Vehicles Owned & Leased By the City.** *Ordinance 93-68.*
- **Taxicab Owners & Drivers have Option to Prohibit Smoking in their Vehicles.** *Ordinance 93-88.*
- **Prohibits Distribution of Sample Tobacco Products & Promotional Items on City Streets, Parks, Sidewalks, and Within 1,000 Feet of School.** *Ordinance 94-82.*

Hawaii County Ordinances:

- **Smoke-Free Workplace.** *February 1, 2004. Smoking Prohibited in Any Restaurant. Sept. 1'04. Exceptions: Bar Area Not Designated Non-Smoking.*

Maui County Council Ordinances:

- **Maui Memorial Hospital is Smoke-Free.** *July 2004.*
- **Smoking Prohibited in any Restaurant.** *Ordinance 3078. January 2003. Exceptions: Nightclubs & Stand-alone bars.*
- **Prohibit Smoking in any Building Owned, Leased Operated or Maintained by the County, & Enclosed Common Areas of Multi-family Dwellings & Multi-tenant Commercial Building, & in Businesses with Public Access.** *1997.*
- **Prohibits Distribution of Sample Tobacco Promotional Materials Within a School Zone (Within 1,000 Feet of a School) and Distribution of Sample Products on Any Public Street, Sidewalk, or Park.** *1997.*

Kauai County:

- **Smoke-Free Workplace.** *January 2003. Exceptions: Workplace with 5 or Less Employees.*
- **Smoking Prohibited in Any Restaurant.** *Ordinance 795. 2002. Exceptions: Nightclubs, Stand-alone bars, "Part-time Restaurant/Bar" only during posted hours operates as bar. (For more information on smoking laws or legislations call (808) 587-0478 or email par@capitol.hawaii.gov)*
