Car Seat Safety for Children with Special Healthcare needs

- Conventional seats may not provide optimum protection in certain situations
- Adaptive or specialized restraints may be necessary
- CP, dwarfism, ASD, Down Syndrome, casts and tractions, Spina Bifida, Obesity...

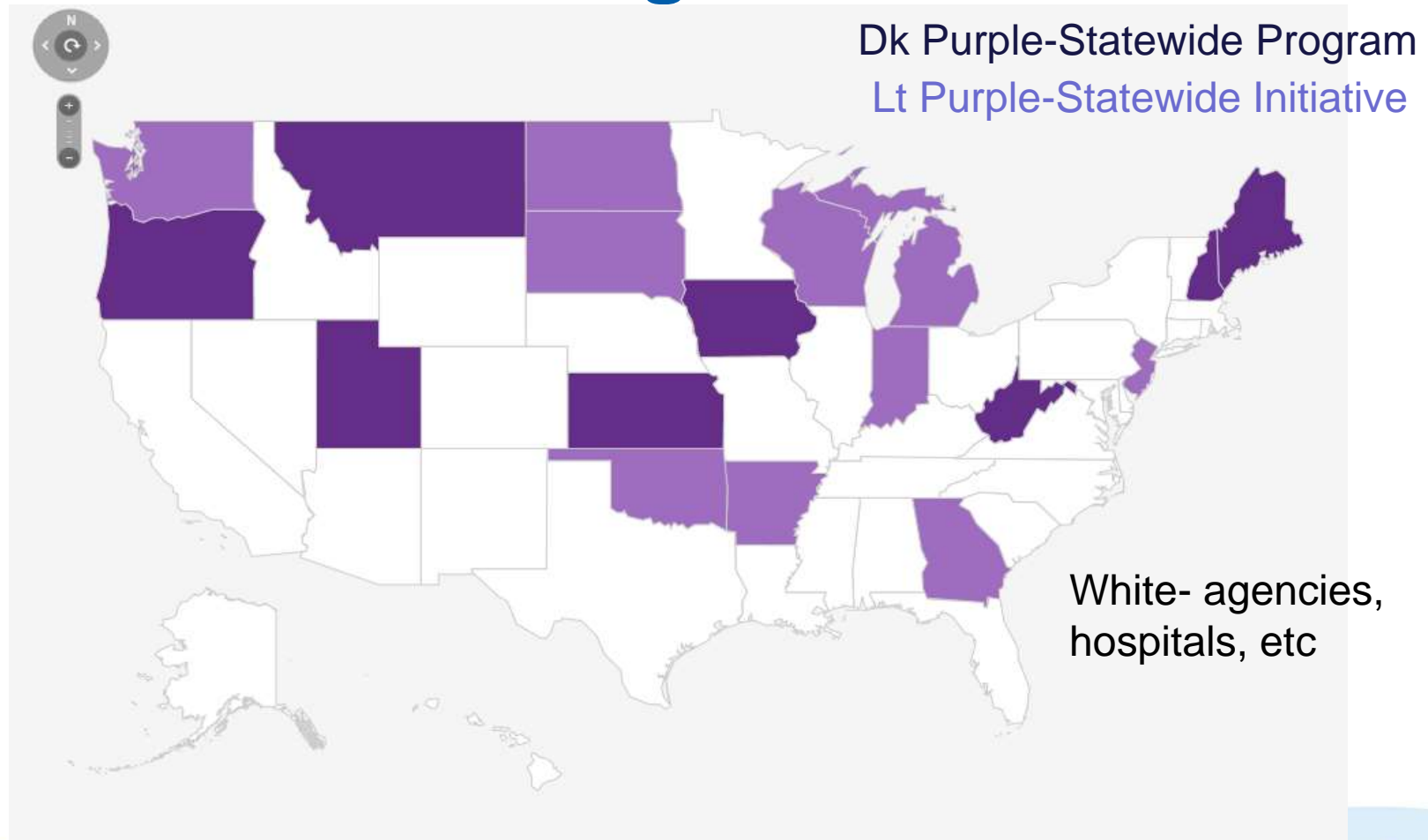

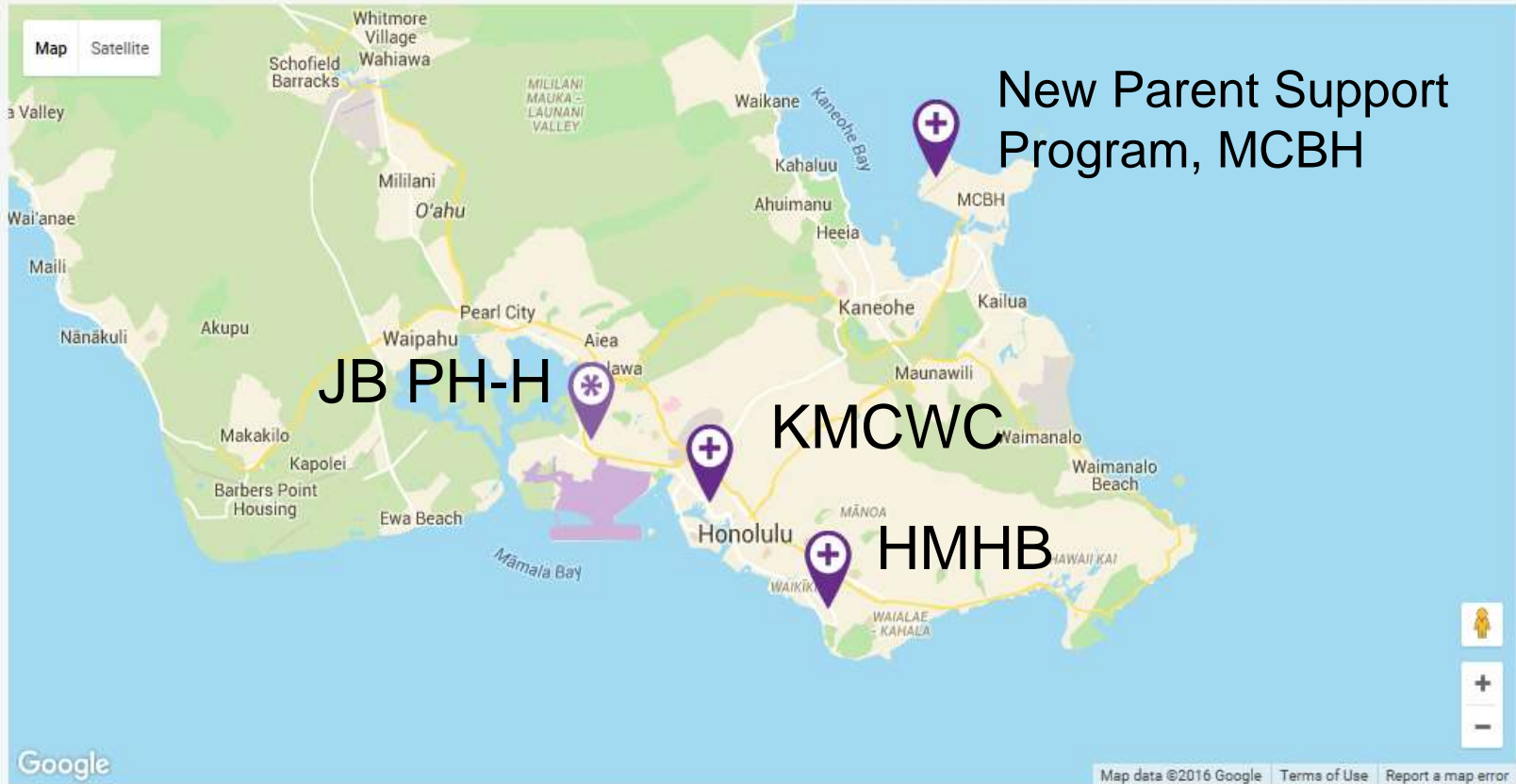
